Inclusion criteria-the experiences and characteristics people need to be in our study



Exclusion criteria- the experiences and characteristics of people who can **not** be in our study

Consent Requirements	How we will do it
 <p>Informed: people have all the information they need about the study</p>	
 <p>Voluntary: people making a choice without pressure from other people</p>	
 <p>Ongoing: people can say no at any time during the study.</p>	

When we work with legally authorized representatives (LARs) and guardians, we will show respect for the person with a LAR’s decision-making by:



Privacy and Confidentiality

We will keep people's information private and confidential by:

While we are recruiting
While we are collecting information (data)
While we are working with information (data analysis)
While we are sharing what we learned from the research study

Confidentiality Agreement


An important job I have is keeping information private and confidential.

I agree that:

- I will only talk about who is in the research study with people on the research team.
- I will keep information about anyone in the research study or who I talk to about being in the research study private. This means I will only talk about this information with people on the research team.
 - This information includes:
 - Name
 - Birthday
 - Health information
 - Disability and health conditions
 - Other information that can give away who someone is
 - Anything someone shared about their feelings, experiences, and things they do
- I will tell the project lead if I find out someone's information did not stay private.

Keeping Research Participants Safe
